



Information Sheet for Provisional Licence Holders

Requirements

In New South Wales, security guards holding a current Provisional Class 1 security licence must successfully complete a Certificate II in Security Operations (CPP20207) and/or a Certificate III in Security Operations (CPP30407) in order to upgrade their provisional licence to a full security licence.

The qualifications can be achieved via Work Place Assessments (WPA)

1A	Static and Mobile Guard	the licensee to patrol, protect, watch or guard any property while unarmed (and whether while static or mobile).		
1C	Crowd Controller	the licensee to act as a crowd controller, venue controller or bouncer or to act in similar capacity.		
1E	Monitoring Room Operator	the licensee to patrol, protect, watch or guard any property while carrying on monitoring centre operations		
1G	Loss Prevention Officer	the licensee to patrol, protect, watch or guard any property while carrying on retail loss prevention		
CPP30407 Certificate III in Security Operations			3	\$750.00
1B	Bodyguard	the licensee to act as a bodyguard or to provide close personal protection or to act in a similar capacity.		
1D	Dog Handler	the licensee to patrol, protect, watch or guard any property with a dog.		
1F	Armed Guard	the licensee to carry out cash in transit only, while armed (but only under the authority of a licence or permit to use or possess firearms under the Firearms Act 1996		

Enrolment Process for your Work Place Assessments

On enrolment you will be required to present your provisional licence which will be copied and verified. An underpinning knowledge assessment and Language, Literacy and Numeracy Skills Test are undertaken at enrolment. All failures in LL&N Test are reported to SELD. You will be provided with information on the assessment tasks that the assessor will use as a means of measuring your competency in the workplace.

We will provide you with the letter for you to deliver to your employer to allow us access to assess you in the workplace. The employer can place restrictions upon access to your work place and observations of some of your activities.

Work Place Assessments

We will arrange a suitable time for you, your employer and our assessor to undertake the workplace assessments. After obtaining approval from your employer, our assessor will visit your workplace to conduct assessment and collect evidence. The assessor will observe your skills and activities and will ask questions to determine your knowledge of your job or role. If necessary the assessor will create scenarios to assess skills that you may not be able to readily demonstrate. After conducting the final assessment and submission of any tasks allocated to you, the evidences are assessed.

Qualifications are awarded, if assessments are successfully completed.

Please note:

- Work Place Assessments can only be conducted after two months, once you receive your Provisional Licence.
- A gap of two month is mandatory between two work place assessments.
