Certificate IV in Security and Risk Management - (CPP40707)

This course is suitable for security consultants, security managers, security master licence holders and security risk managers. It is designed for persons responsible for security in various sectors, such as retail, financial, government, military, hospital and hospitality, who require skills necessary to evaluate security vulnerability and risk, and develop security counter measures. It covers national competency standards applicable to security risk management, industry-wide.

Student Selection Criteria for Certificate IV in Security (Risk Management)

- Minimum entry requirement is Year 12 or equivalent or be mature age (20 years or older) and have at least 2 years full time work experience in security or management
